

FOCHSP Trail Days January 13, 2024

On a very cold and windy Saturday morning, eighteen Friends of Cape Henlopen State Park volunteers came to the park for our monthly cleanup. A total of 29.5 hours of volunteer time was provided. Led by Trail Days coordinator Fran Giacoma, the team cleaned along the popular Seaside Nature Trail as well as the bay beach. They continued on to the fishing pier parking lot and paved areas along the bike trail loop before returning to the Seaside Nature Center. Approximately, 25 lbs. of trash were collected plus the bonus of a damaged drone which will be "recycled".



2023 Volunteer Review

272 members volunteered for the Friends in 2023. That's about 65% of our membership.

As is usual, the Bike Barn came out as the top volunteering spot followed by our highly attended events. Top three volunteered events include Xmas Boutique- 537 hrs., Choco. Tasting- 253 hrs., & B, W & Cheese Tasting- 178 hrs. Many members only contribute for a single event or for a few hours but as the annual summary shows, volunteerism IS a hallmark of our organization.
